Most people use Indeed and LinkedIn when searching for a job; they are good sites to start with. However, other, less-known platforms can be helpful in your job search. I have compiled a list of some of these lesser-known sites below to assist you in your search

Tech & Startup Roles

- **Wellfound (formerly AngelList Talent):** The primary site for startups, offering free profiles and direct connections to founders.
- **Built In:** Features tech-focused roles in major tech hubs (NYC, LA, Chicago, etc.) and offers strong remote filters.
- **Arc.dev:** Ideal for developers looking for permanent or high-caliber freelance remote work.
- **Dice:** While well-known, many miss its strong free features for IT, software, and engineering roles.

Remote-First & Freelance

- **We Work Remotely (WWR):** One of the largest, most trusted communities for remote jobs, covering marketing, programming, and design.
- **JobLeads:** The platform on your side, specializing in remote jobs
- **Remote.co:** Vetted remote listings across various categories, including customer service, HR, and virtual assistance.
- **Remotive:** Hand-picked remote jobs, largely focusing on tech, sales, and marketing.
- **Hubstaff Talent:** Completely free for job seekers, specializing in connecting remote workers with employers.
- **NoDesk:** Curated remote roles for digital nomads and freelancers, with no sign-up required to browse.
- **SkipTheDrive:** Simplifies the remote job search by focusing on work-from-home and flexible jobs.

Niche & Creative Industries

- **Behance:** Owned by Adobe, this is a top site for creative professionals (designers, animators, illustrators) to find jobs based on their portfolios.

- **Idealist:** The premier site for finding jobs, internships, and volunteer roles in the non-profit sector.
- **HigherEdJobs:** Specializes in administrative and academic roles at universities.
- **Poached:** A niche board specifically for restaurant and hospitality jobs.
- **TeamWork Online:** Focuses on sports and entertainment industry jobs.

Entry-Level & Specialized

- **Handshake:** Best for college students and recent graduates, connecting them directly with employers.
- **Learn4Good:** Often used for internships and roles with lower barriers to entry.
- **RecruitMilitary:** Specializes in finding roles for veterans and transitioning service members.
- **JobSpider:** A no-frills "Craigslist-like" site that allows you to post resumes for free.
- **LinkUp (Getwork):** Aggregates jobs directly from company career pages, often uncovering listings not found on job boards.

These sites often have less competition than larger platforms, making them effective for targeted job searches.
